P.A.C's group framework is intended to provide marginalized and at-risk pre-adolescent and adolescents, ages 12-18, with a space to explore a wide range of issues that impact their daily lives.

The group provides adolescents with the opportunity to explore through their life experiences, as well as their strengths and daily lived realities in a safe and non-threatening environment.

P.A.C group nurtures and reinforces a positive identity with inherent strengths to support healthy self-expression. This framework strives to rebuild the village by providing decision-making models and life skills to aid in the transition to adulthood.

The framework utilizes a relational/cultural model that can be applied to adolescents in a variety of contexts, including adolescents dealing with; emotional or behavioral problems, truancy, low academic performance, showing a lack of interest for academics, and expressing a disconnection from the school environment, and issues of marginalization including poverty, homelessness, bullying, anxiety with school shootings, and the intersections of oppression.

Family 360's innovative P.A.C group program models and provides a framework to guide the prevention and intervention of at-risk adolescents through participating in a talking circle, expressive arts, games, and activities.
